



Ashfield Community Involvement Award

The winner of the award will receive a one-time \$3,000 bursary towards the cost of fees to attend College, University or an approved apprenticeship program. Up to five awards are available to OCSB graduating students. The intent of this award is to provide support to students who have significant financial challenges associated with continuing their post-secondary pathway.

CRITERIA

The successful candidate must demonstrate school or community involvement.

The student must have a minimum 70% average and be able to meet all of the requirements for an OSS diploma by the end of the current school year.

The student must be accepted for studies at a College or University.

SELECTION PROCESS

Please outline, on an attached sheet (8 ½ by 11), up to two pages in length, why you are applying for this award.

Your application should make reference to the following areas:

1. Involvement at your school and/or involvement in your community
2. Your future academic plans or goals
3. How the award would assist with any financial challenges associated with attending a post-secondary program
4. Other information as needed to support your nomination - a maximum of two additional reference letters may accompany your application

AWARD

A bursary of \$3,000
