CRITERIA

To be selected, a student must:

- Have achieved a high academic average in their Grade 11 and Grade 12 subjects,
- Have completed all the requirements for obtaining an OSS diploma, including the community service component,
- Have consistently demonstrated positive social attitudes throughout his/her years of high school.
- Have consistently exemplified the expectations of the Ontario Catholic School Graduate,
- Be a self directed, responsible, lifelong learner who develops and demonstrates his/her God-given potential,
- Be a caring, individual who attends to family, school, parish and to the wider community,
- Be accepted at a university or college.

SELECTION PROCESS

School-based Honours and Awards Committee will determine the appropriate candidate. The Honours & Awards liaison will submit one name no later than May 11, 2018.

AWARD

A bursary of \$1500 and a certificate to one student from each Catholic High School

1. Applicants must submit complete package to the school based Honours & Awards Coordinator by the assigned due date.
