



Ottawa Catholic Trustee Service Award

CRITERIA

One graduate in each High School will be selected. To be selected a student must have:

- Demonstrated extensive service in school activities for a minimum of three years;
- Demonstrated service in the community and/or fundraising involvement;
- Taken initiative and demonstrated leadership;
- Completed all the requirements for obtaining an OSS diploma;
- Not be serving as an Ottawa Catholic School Board Student Trustee.

SELECTION PROCESS

School-Based Honours and Awards Committee will select three applicants and submit those applications to the Chairperson of the Honours and Awards Committee through Brenda Wilson, Superintendent, by internal courier, no later than April 13, 2018, to determine final selection with the zone Trustees and interview candidates at their school.

REQUIREMENTS

Each candidate will each submit a one-page resume (using point form, not essay format) detailing the above criteria. **PLEASE ATTACH THIS RESUME TO THE APPLICATION FORM.**

AWARD

A bursary of \$1500 and a certificate to one student from each Catholic High School

1. Applicants must submit complete package to the school based Honours & Awards Coordinator by the assigned due date.

2. School-based Honours & Awards Coordinator will submit three (3) nominations for the **Ottawa Catholic Trustee Service Award** to the office of Superintendent, Brenda Wilson.
