CRITERIA

Graduating students who have demonstrated outstanding achievement in their OYAP.

Applicants *must* have completed all of the requirements for obtaining an OSS Diploma, including the community service component

SELECTION PROCESS

Particular focus, but without limiting such focus, will be given to students who:

- ◆ Have demonstrated special dedication to pursuing a career in the skilled trades;
- ◆ Have attained outstanding achievement in the view of their employers and cooperative education teachers;
- ◆ Have demonstrated a well-rounded achievement in their education and community involvement;
- ◆ Have attained outstanding achievement in the context of economic, cultural or social barriers.

The school-based Honours and Awards Selection Committee is to submit one application per school to Brenda Wilson, Superintendent, by internal courier, no later than May 4, 2018. The recipient will be determined by the Board Selection Committee.

AWARD

A bursary of \$700 and a certificate to one graduating student from the Ottawa Catholic School Board.

1. Applicants must submit complete package to the school based Honours & Awards Coordinator by the assigned due date.

2. School-based Honours & Awards Coordinator will submit one (1) nomination for the OYAP Award to the office of Superintendent, Brenda Wilson.
