



## National Bank of Canada Graduate Award

### CRITERIA

1. Applicants must have completed all the requirements for obtaining an OSS diploma, including the community service component.
2. Planning to take a post-secondary program in college or university.
3. Applicants are requested to write a short essay on managing debt for their anticipated post-secondary costs, this could include credit card, student loan or any other type of debt management.

### SELECTION PROCESS

*School-based Honours and Awards Committee* will determine the appropriate candidate. The Honours & Awards liaison will submit one name no later than May 11, 2018. The recipient will be determined by the Board Selection Committee.

### AWARD

Two awards of a \$1000 each will be provided to graduating students of the Ottawa Catholic School Board. A representative from *The National Bank of Canada* will present the award to the student at the graduation ceremony.

1. Applicants must submit complete package to the school based Honours & Awards Coordinator by the assigned due date.

2. School-based Honours & Awards Coordinator will submit one (1) nomination for the **National Bank of Canada Graduate Award** to the office of Superintendent, Brenda Wilson.
